Understanding Plot with <u>Tully's Alpine Adventure</u>

Grade Level: Primary (K-3)

Subject: Language Arts / Storytelling

Length: 30-40 minutes

Objective

Students will learn that a plot is the series of events that happen in a story. They will identify the beginning, middle, and end of the plot in Tully's Alpine Adventure.

Materials

- Book: Tully's Alpine Adventure (read aloud or picture walk)
- Chart paper or whiteboard
- Story plot graphic organizer (Beginning, Middle, End)
- Drawing paper and crayons/colored pencils

Lesson Steps

- 1. Introduction (5 minutes)
- Ask: What makes a story fun to read?
- Explain: A plot is what happens in the story. Stories usually have a beginning, middle, and end.
- 2. Guided Discovery (10 minutes)
- Read or picture-walk Tully's Alpine Adventure.
- Discuss events in the story:
 - Beginning Introduce Tully, Wooliam, and Lambkin in their Alpine world.
 - Middle The characters explore, solve a problem, or go on an adventure.
 - End The story wraps up and the characters return safely.
- Write events on chart paper in three sections: Beginning, Middle, End.
- 3. Activity (10-12 minutes)
- Students draw three boxes on paper.
- In Box 1, draw the Beginning of Tully's story.
- In Box 2, draw the Middle of Tully's story.


- In Box 3, draw the End of Tully's story.
- Share drawings with the class.
- 4. Closing Discussion (5 minutes)
- Ask: What did we learn about plot?
- Emphasize: Every story has a plot that moves from the beginning, to the middle, to the end.
- Connect to real life: Just like a story has a plot, our days also have a beginning, middle, and end.

Assessment

- Students can describe a plot as the events of a story.
- Students can identify at least one event in the beginning, middle, and end of Tully's Alpine Adventure.

Extension Ideas

- Act out the plot of Tully's Alpine Adventure in three short scenes.
- Create a class story with a simple beginning, middle, and end.
- Compare Tully's plot with another story the class has read.
