Social-Emotional Lesson Plan: Compassion

This lesson uses the book <u>Tully's Alpine Adventure</u> as the central story to introduce and explore the theme.

Focus

Helping students understand and practice compassion by recognizing others' feelings and showing care.

Objectives

- Students will identify moments of compassion in <u>Tully's Alpine Adventure</u>.
- Students will demonstrate compassionate actions through role-play.
- Students will reflect on times they have shown or received compassion.

Activities

- Read aloud selected pages where Tully helps or comforts another character.
- Class brainstorm: What does compassion look like, sound like, feel like?
- Role-play activity: Students act out scenarios of showing compassion.

Discussion Questions

- How did Tully show compassion in the story?
- How did the other characters feel when someone showed them kindness?
- What are ways we can show compassion in our classroom and community?

Closing Reflection

Students draw a picture of themselves showing compassion to someone and share with the class.
